## Class Survey Results

### Q1 Are you able to follow the lectures or are you feeling inundated with information?

- Able to follow most of it, but sometimes you do make big leaps. [Background info: I haven't taken your CSE 471]

- It's hard to see how you grade paper reviews. I feel uncomfortable that there are no simple, drill, rote problems that form the course's core. Without mastering these somehow, I'll only get a broad idea and won't be able to solve concrete problems. I am having a hard enough time with some of your CSE 471 & Textbook problems & will feel happy only when I'm totally at ease with them.  
Even if I don't know the bleeding edge ideas like Quadratic Graphs or whatever, I \*do\* want to be able to solve simple planning problems in my head, just like I write binary tree search or SQL Queries.
